IRS REQUIREMENT: 990-N (e-postcard)

The e-postcard will require the PTA to provide the following information:

- * Organization's name
- * Any other names your organization uses
- * Organization's mailing address
- Organization's website address (if applicable)
- Organization's employer identification number
 (EIN)
- Name and address of a principal officer of the PTA
- * Organization's annual tax period, July 1-June 30
- * A statement that your PTA's annual gross receipts are normally \$50,000 or less, and
- * If applicable, indicate if your PTA is going out of business.

All PTAs, including those that are tax exempt under sections 501(c)(3) and 501(c)(4) **that have a revenue of less than \$50,000** are required to file an annual electronic IRS Form 990-N (e-postcard).

The e-postcard for the 2012-2013 fiscal year must be filed by November 15, 2013.

The e-postcard must to filed electronically. There is no paper form. To file, go to http://epostcard.form990.org/

You do not need to purchase any software to file. Organizations that do not have access to a computer can go to places that provide Internet access to the public, such as their local library, to file the e-postcard. (However, you will need an email address to file this form.)

You will receive an email confirmation indicating whether or not your e-postcard was accepted by the IRS. If your e-postcard is rejected, the email will tell you who to contact to resolve the problem.

Keep a copy of the electronic filing. You need to be able to provide this for public information.
